Dear Parents,

We will be opening enrollment for our school age summer program to the general public on Monday, May 7th. Prior to open enrollment we extend the opportunity for parents who currently have school age children in our centers to reserve their spot for the summer program. This offer also applies to parents who have younger children currently enrolled at Kid's Connection. KC Camp is designed to offer a variety of activities that will keep the interest of most school age children. Attached you will find a tentative schedule of our summer plans for 2018. This schedule is subject to change.

The weekly tuition for KC Camp is \$115.00. We are unable to offer part time rates. Payment is required on Monday of the current week. The activity fee that is charged to all campers is \$50.00. This fee will cover all on site supplies/activities. If you choose to have your camper participate in off site field trips your fee will be \$140.00. If you choose to have your camper participate in all off site activities and visit the Jeffersonville Aquatic Center then your fee will be \$200.00. All activity fees must be paid no later than May 7th. Tuition rate remains the same as last year. Off site activities have increased by \$20.00 from last year.

Mrs. Tish & Ms. Lauren will be overseeing the camp program at Sellersburg. Mrs. Courtney & Mr. Paxton will be assisting them. Ms. Jackie will be overseeing the camp program at Jeffersonville, and she will be assisted by Ms. Allysan.

With the added responsibility of taking the children off site there will be absolutely no room for behavior problems. This is necessary to ensure the safety of all campers and staff. If we have continuous behavior problems with your child at the center, on the bus or on the field trips your child will be dismissed from KC Camp. It is vital that you stress to your child the importance of listening and responding appropriately to all staff in charge. Campers will receive one verbal warning concerning their behavior. If the behavior continues the camper will be suspended from the next field trip. Parents will be notified at pick up of any behavior issues. The activity fee is non-refundable. If your child is suspended form a trip for behavior issues the fee for that trip will not be refunded.

Parents & Camper's,

Welcome to KC Camp. We are excited to be hosting our sixteenth KC Camp. We will follow the posted schedule as closely as possible. Changes will be noted on the KC Camp room door. Be sure to check this each afternoon when picking up your camper.

Toys from Home: Campers are welcome to bring toys from home. However, they will be responsible for these items. The center is not responsible for any broken or missing items that are brought from home. I encourage campers to put their name on any materials brought from home.

Screen Time: There will be specific times during the day that the children will be allowed to play with their electronics. They will not be allowed to sit all day in front of a screen. We encourage physical activity and non screen activity each day.

Note: We do not allow toy weapons, music with suggestive content or foul language, or games with suggestive or violent content.

Money for Concessions at the Pool: Children are welcome to bring money for concessions at the pool. There will be a camp bank that one of the staff will be in charge of. Campers will put their money in the camp bank (an envelope with their name on it). When we arrive at the pool the children will be allowed to get their money from the bank for concessions and return any change to the bank for use at a later time.

Daily Needs: Sunscreen, Change of Clothes, Bathing Suit and Towel if your camper is a swimmer.

Sack Lunches: On days that we have sack lunch the camper is welcome to pack his/her own, or the center will provide one for them. If you do pack a lunch from home we do not allow Mt. Dew or energy drinks due to the caffeine content.

Camp Rules

- Do not scream indoors or on the bus
- Listen to the staff at all times
- No bullying
- No back talking or sassing
- · No cussing, no spitting, no pinching, no hitting, no kicking, no slapping
